The John Day River is protected as Wild and Scenic River. Your adventure will start below the North and South forks of the John Day and end approximately 33 miles down this remote and historical river. During this adventure you will float by many rock formations and landmarks like Coffin Rock and the beautiful Cathedral Rock. You will experience lots of wildlife such as deer, herons, otters, coyotes, and chukars. This magnificent country will yield many memorable photographs.

THE FISHING: Catch 50 plus bass a day from half to four pounds each. These fish are a wonderful thrill on light tackle. For the fly fisherman, it is a dream. Imagine the peacefulness of the outdoors being interrupted by these ferocious fish when your top water fly hits the water along with some great nymph fishing as well. This is a great trip for both the beginner and the experienced fly fisherman. The John Day River is a great family getaway. Kids and their parents can enjoy the great outdoors together while everyone catches fish.

THE FOOD/THE CAMP: The camp will be set up when you arrive in the evening. Relax around camp over cocktails while telling fish stories about your day. The food is prepared by the guides and our camp chef. While in camp you may fish, swim, hike, or just relax. We furnish tents and six inch thick air mattresses for your comfort. You will be served breakfast and dinner in camp and a shore lunch that is prepared by the guides. This is a trip of spectacular views, fantastic fishing, and just plain relaxing. SEASON: The John Day is located in Oregon's high desert region and is a free flowing river, so warm weather and water levels play a key role in creating a great trip.
