Rogue's Wild and Scenic River Adventure...

The Lower Rogue River is not just a fishing trip, it's a fishing adventure. Explore a 65 mile journey down the Wild and Scenic Rogue River that offers spectacular scenery, white water excitement and plenty of wildlife that is rich with history and romance of the old west, where Zane Gray spent his time fly fishing and writing novels. The scenery and wildlife are so spectacular that nearly 40 years ago the U.S. Congress protected it by declaring the area Wild and Scenic. Meaning, your trip won't be spoiled by unsightly dams, homes, or roads. The number of people per group allowed to float 37 miles of this 65 mile trip is restricted to just 12 participants per day. It looks and feels the same as it did 100 years ago.

THE FISHING: Enjoy four full days of guided fishing for Chinook and Coho salmon mixed with a prolific run of summer steelhead and half pounders as they work their way to the upper reaches of the Rogue. Fish range in size from 8 to 30 pounds with the opportunity to catch that once in a lifetime 45 pound salmon you have always dreamed of catching. Your adventure can offer a unique fishing experience as you side-drift with light weight spinning rods for fresh migrating Kings and Coho just a short distance from where the Rogue meets the mighty Pacific Ocean. This is a great fishery for both the spin casting and fly fishing enthusiast.

THE LODGING / THE FOOD: After a long day on the water you will retire in the comfort of a different lodge setting every night as you work your way down river. Each lodge offers great home cooked meals, hot showers and comfortable beds to end that perfect day of fishing. Black Bar Lodge, Half Moon Bar Lodge and Illahe Lodge all offer their own unique style of hospitality and crea-

ture comforts. Throughout your journey you will feast on home prepared riverside lunches of fresh cold cuts, vegetables and cookies and enjoy the great cuisine of fresh caught salmon and steelhead fillets barbecued and smoked over Alder and deep fried steelhead for a new taste sensation.

WHITEWATER EXCITEMENT: For those of you who seek adventure, this is the trip for you. You will experience invigorating Class 3 and 4 rapids like Tye and Wildcat Rapid, Slim Pickens, Upper Black Bar Falls, Kelsey Creek Canyon and the thrill ride through Mule Creek Canyon and finally Blossom Bar. Watch as your guide's line their boats around Rainie Falls while enjoying the view of migrating salmon and steelhead leaping their way up the falls. This is truly whitewater excitement that will make you glad you chose an experienced guide.

BEST TIMES: Our trips in the Lower Rogue River Canyon begin on September 1st, and run through November 15th. The Bureau of Land Management and U.S. Forest Service regulate which days we can launch and how many people can launch each day. This insures that your trip is a real wilderness adventure.

THE LODGES: Black Bar, Marial, and Illahe

INCLUSIONS:

- Three / Four days of fishing
- Two / Three nights lodging
- Transportation to the launch and pickup at the end of the trip
- All fishing rods, fly fishing rods and terminal tackle
- Patient, friendly and very experienced guide
- Complete instruction in all types of fishing methods, including fly-fishing instruction
- Breakfast and dinner at the lodge and gourmet riverside lunches by our crew (includes cooked fish on day two and three)
- Non-alcoholic beverages i.e. water, diet drinks, juice, sodas and Gatorade
- Dry bags provided for transporting your personal items and keeping them dry
- Satellite cell telephones for any important or emergency calls

COST:

3-Day Trip: \$2250 per boat (1 or 2 people per boat) plus a 6% government / land use fee.

4-Day Trip: \$2700 per boat (1 or 2 people per boat) plus a 6% government / land use fee.
